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PRSRT STD US POSTAGE PAID SAN DIEGO CA PERMIT #2029

Presorted Standard Indicia.

Standard Mail is used for advertising mail, catalogues, and newsletters of a non-personal nature that are not required to be mailed as First-Class Mail.

Standard Mail must weigh less than 16 ounces. A minimum volume of 200 identical pieces of mail (or 50 pounds) is required. Text of the permit indicia must be printed as shown in the example, PRSRT STD abbreviated as shown, or spelled out completely as PRESORTED STANDARD. Permit #2029 is assigned to The Mailing Group; your own postal permit number may be used in its place. Presorted NON-PROFIT ORG Indicia.

Organizations that meet specific standards for qualified nonprofit organizations and that have received specific authorization from the USPS may mail eligible matter at the Nonprofit Standard Mail rates. Characteristics are generally the same as for Standard Mail, with some restrictions on promotional and advertising material. All non-profit mail must have the organizations name and return mailing address on the mail piece, and must match the information on file with the USPS.

A non-profit authorization number is REQUIRED for any mail submitted at Non-Profit rates. To obtain your organizations non-profit authorization number, the request must be made on your letterhead and submitted to the USPS Mailing Requirements office. In San Diego, California, please fax your request to (858) 674-0055 – or call USPS Mailing Requirements at (858) 674-0400.

Any questions regarding Non-Profit eligibility should be directed to the USPS.

PRESORTED FIRST CLASS US POSTAGE PAID SAN DIEGO CA PERMIT #2029

Presorted FIRST CLASS MAIL Indicia.

First-Class Mail includes all matter wholly or partly in writing or typewriting, all actual and personal correspondence, all bills and statements of account, and all matter sealed or otherwise closed against inspection. The minimum volume per bulk mailing is 500 addressed pieces. First-Class mail may be postcards, letters, flats or parcels.

CALL FOR OTHER CLASSES OF MAIL

There are many additional specifications and requirements for any mail to be eligible for presorted or automation dicsounted rates, including size, weight, thickness, placements of text, graphics and clear space areas.
